The Legislative District 11 team of Senator Steve Smith, Representative Mark Finchem and Representative Vince Leach is pleased to offer our endorsement of **Ally Miller to represent the District 1 residents of Pima County** as their County Supervisor.

Over the last 4 years Supervisor Miller has worked with State Legislators to seek solutions to issues that directly affect all of Pima County.
